Methodology <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Defined Objectives • Audit: Review of practice against recognised existing standards • Research: Adequately tests hypothesis, consideration given to ethics / randomisation / blinding • Survey: Good representation and response rate (aim 70-80%) – feasible to achieve the same across the network. • Well executed pilot study • Good consideration of statistical methods required for analysis 	
Presentation of Content <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clear, organised and without ambiguity • 	
Potential for Impact <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pilot Study demonstrated significant / interesting results • Clear scope for change in practice • Good potential for abstract submission and publication 	
Feasibility for adoption by the network <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Results relevant across London / Network • Applicable to other than local practice • Easy to run 'on the ground' by local investigator, with consideration given to differing resources available at each site.
